

HOW TO BECOME ACQUAINTED WITH YOUR SPEED CONTROL

Operation of Speed Reminder Feature

This feature is a safety feature designed for driving in urban and other congested areas:

1. Set speed control switch to ON position.
2. Rotate speed selector dial to your approximate desired speed. Drive your car in the normal manner, and when your selected speed is reached, an added back pressure will be felt on the accelerator pedal. Adjust selector dial as required to arrive at your actual desired speed.
3. Hold the accelerator pedal at the point where back pressure is felt and you will maintain your selected speed. Back pressure point will vary with the road grade. Follow this back pressure point with your foot on the accelerator pedal as the car goes up or down hill.
4. You can increase the car speed at any time by pushing the accelerator through the back pressure. Release the pressure on the accelerator pedal and your car will slow down normally.

Speed control is inoperative when switch is in OFF position.
